



Our 14th annual concert will feature organ selections by organist Michael Kiehner including the following: Festive Prelude on *Cwm Rhondda*, an interesting setting of the great Welsh hymn by David P. Dahl; In My Homeland, a plaintive piece by the great Norwegian composer Edvard Grieg; the African American spiritual I've Been in the Storm So Long, arranged by David Kidwell; a sprightly adaptation of the English Carol I Saw Three Ships by David Clark Isele; the powerful Prelude and Fugue in A Minor by Johann Sebastian Bach; three movements from the suite Carnival by Robert Crandell; Variations sur *Amazing Grace* by the French Canadian composer Denis Bedard.

A choir made up of some of the finest voices in the area under the direction of Catherine Stohn Zimmerman will sing the following four selections: Joyfully Sing, a rousing anthem by Cindy Berry featuring Christian Honicker on the trumpet; Sweet By and By, a jazzy setting of the beloved gospel hymn by Marianne Kim; Marchin' with the Saints, a joyous combination of *When the Saints Go Marching In* and *Give Me That Old Time Religion* by Patti Drennan; The Heavens Are Telling from Franz Josef Haydn's *The Creation*, featuring a trio by Pam Leib, John Potlunas and Dave Sterner.

There will also be congregational singing during and light refreshments served after the concert.
