I have imagery in my mind as I sit at my desk to type this edition of my newsletter article. The imagery I have is that of a fireplace and a fire-side chat...made famous (*at least*) by President Franklin Roosevelt. I also partially have that imagery in my mind because I'm cold (ugh), and because there are two copies of Trinity's old "We have a story to tell" Christmas outreach ministry that has just been restarted and republished in the Republican Herald last month (*perhaps you may have seen it*).



If we were to sit back, close our eyes, and imagine this fireplace there are many things our senses bring to us. Our sense of touch brings us the feel of the warmth of a fireplace as the heat escapes from the tomb in which it is located; and fills and encompasses the open and colder space all around.

Our sense of sight brings us the image of the bright flames bringing light into a darker space. The light that comes into the room and the room's darkness unable to stand against this new light.

Our sense of hearing is fully engaged as we hear the crackling of the flames as they burn away at the embers below, and the popping of the sparks that shoot out from the flames that constitute the source of the light and warmth before us. As though each crackling and spark are words written in a book describing the events of the fireplace as it becomes part of our lives.

And our sense of smell is truly working overtime as the burning wood provides a pleasant aroma to the air in the room and brings us a sense of calm, warmth, and peace within the context of our surroundings



And our sense of taste is heightened as we further imagine marshmallows, or smores, or some type of meal being prepared in a wood fired oven, or over a firepit.

As we sit back and embrace the imagery of this fireplace, we find it is striking in similarity in its functioning, and our sense-filled responses, to the light of Christ coming into our lives.

Amid our dark and cold winter, may the light of Christ Jesus embrace you where you are, and may the warmth of Christ Jesus fill you with the knowledge that God is active and present within our circumstances.

ROCK-A-THON 2020

When the confirmation committee met last summer to plan our year, we scheduled **February 15** as a special service project day. At the time, we had no idea what this project would look like except for two things: It would be a fundraising event and those funds would be used to help someone else. At our confirmation class on January 12, our kids brainstormed, voted and came up with a pretty solid project. They decided they wanted to do the **Rock-A-Thon**. Many of you may remember this event as we had done this for (probably) close to 20 years. The event involves kids climbing into rockers and rocking for 24 hours. It also involves kids soliciting sponsors or pledges for their work. A final component is selecting who (or what) they “Rock for”. Kids had their choice of voting for Make-A-Wish, 2 different summer camps (for youth who are either physically or mentally challenged) or to help offset medical and equipment expenses for *Jaden Leiby*. They chose to “*Rock for Jaden*”.

Jaden, a senior at North Schuylkill High School, was critically injured last fall during a football game between N. Schuylkill and Pottsville. Jaden has been improving daily, still has a long road ahead of him; and is looking forward to coming home in the near future. All money raised in our *Rockin' for Jaden* service project will be placed in an irrevocable trust, held by M & T Bank and will be used for current and future medical/equipment/supply expenses.

Youth in grades 3 – 12 are invited to join the Rock-A-Thon. It begins on Saturday, February 15 at 9 am and ends Sunday, February 16 at 9 am. Kids in grades 3 – 5 will rock for 12 hours (Feb. 15, 9 am – 9 pm) and those in grades 6 – 12 will rock for 24 hours. **Youth wishing to rock must pre-register. Pre-registration closes February 7.** You may preregister by “signing” one of several registration lists, taking a registration packet and returning Registration/Emergency form **PRIOR** to February 7, 2020. The lists and packet are located in the lounge (by the steps going up to the Sanctuary) and on the table by the bulletin board outside the Youth Lounge in the main Sunday School room. Youth may also preregister by emailing child’s name, grade and parent’s name(s) and phone number to:

When registering by e-mail a packet will be returned to you via e-mail. You may return the registration form via email or bring to church.

Finally, a few notes:

- Kids must supply their own rocker.

- Kids may invite friends, but they must be registered and complete (and return) the registration form prior to FEBRUARY 7, 2020.

- Registration forms may be hand delivered to Joan Honicker, Judy Rile, Cindy McGeever, Karen Wood, Pastor Chris or the church office. They may also be emailed to tlcpottsvilleconfirmation@gmail.com

- Kids bring a bagged lunch and a snack to share. PLEASE NO NUTS OR PEANUT BUTTER.

- Dinner and breakfast (for those staying overnight) will be provided. We are asking for the following donation to offset food costs:

 - Kids in grades 3 – 5: \$3.00

 - Kids in grades 6 – 12: \$5.00

- Kids must collect sponsors/pledges beyond **just** their parents. The idea behind this is to raise awareness and help others through our work.

You'll be seeing/hearing more about this event through bulletins, Temple Talks, and social media postings. We ask that you keep our kids in your prayers as they go about ministry on behalf of others.

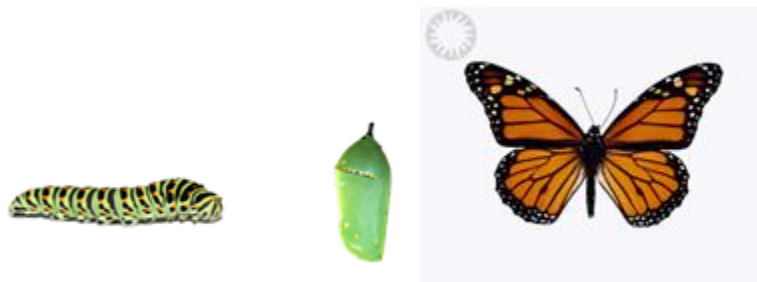
FAMILY AFFAIR

Confirmation students are planning an afternoon of fun for kids ages 2 through Grade 2 and their parents. The event will take place on Sunday, April 5 from 2 – 6 pm. The day includes an Easter Egg hunt, games, crafts, dinner and a lot of family fun. More information about this event will be forthcoming, we just want to make sure you mark the date on your calendar and plan on attending. Your kids will be glad you did!!!

BUTTERFLY PROJECT

Confirmation students are working on a "Butterfly Project" symbolizing the transformation that occurs at our Baptism. Butterflies have become synonymous with "transformation", as a butterfly is born a caterpillar, creates a cocoon and emerges from the cocoon as a beautiful butterfly. At our Baptism, God adopts us into His family, gives us the name Child of God and promises us a life beyond this one. At our death we are transformed and re-born into God's kingdom.

Our Confirmation students will attempt to create a "visual" of the way God transformed our life at baptism. During worship the weekend of January 11-12, we asked members to write their name, date of birth and date of baptism on a slip of paper and return it after worship. If you were not at worship that weekend, you can still be a part of our Butterfly Project. All you have to do is complete a slip with your name, date of birth and baptismal date and drop it in the basket. Slips are located in the lounge (by the stairs leading up to Sanctuary). If you were baptized at Trinity and do not know your baptismal date, please write "TLC" on your slip and we will look it up in our baptismal records. If you were not baptized at Trinity and do not know your baptismal date, please simply write your date of birth. Our confirmation kids will then record names and dates on butterflies and display them on the bulletin board located between Trinity Hall and the main Sunday School room. We'll begin work on the display after the Rock-A-Thon.

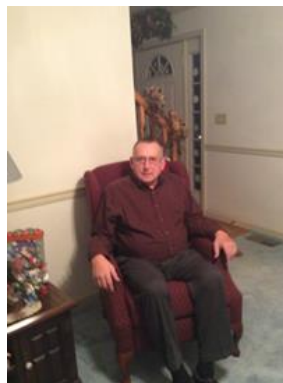

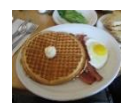
