Brothers and sisters in Christ Jesus,

With thanksgiving we have recently completed our annual journey through the close of November, which affords us the opportunity each year to focus on those persons, (places, and things) the true blessings in our lives for which we are wholly, and on a base existential level, thankful...

We have made it through our Advent season, which each year affords us the opportunity to reflect upon the arrival of the Christ Jesus into our hearts, our minds, our lives...our very human existence, for the purpose of reconciling us with God; opening to us the Kingdom of Heaven; the promise of eternal life...all for the mere request that we give the very best of ourselves to one another as a responsive expression of that love...

And now we come into the light of a New Year, and the beginning of each year for us brings about the liturgical offerings of the season of Epiphany (the time we recognize and remember the arrival of the 3 Wisemen (or 3 kings) who have traveled afar; bearing gifts to present before the newborn Christ-child as a sign of reverence, worship, and awe for what God has bought into our world and lives...

And with this Epiphany season, we are also bought to the font as we recognize the Baptism of our Lord and Savior Christ Jesus (by the hands of John, the baptizer) at the river Jordan...

¹³Then Jesus came from Galilee to John at the Jordan, to be baptized by him. ¹⁴John would have prevented him, saying, "I need to be baptized by you, and do you come to me?" ¹⁵But Jesus answered him, "Let it be so now; for it is proper for us in this way to fulfill all righteousness." Then he consented. ¹⁶And when Jesus had been baptized, just as he came up from the water, suddenly the heavens were opened to him and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting on him. ¹⁷And a voice from heaven said, "This is my Son, the Beloved, with whom I am well pleased." [Matthew 3:13-17 NRSV]

And so, we reflect once again...but at the start of 2024...let us truly reflect...what does this baptism...what does YOUR baptism mean to you as we move forward into 2024?

My baptism is something I often reflect upon because I was not baptized as a child. I was more than 12 years of age in June 1979 when I was finally baptized. My baptism was a family baptism...it bound me, with two of my cousins (one older, and one younger) as we shared our baptisms together by Pastor C. David Godshall at St. Mark's Lutheran church in Birdsboro.

Alongside my cousins at the font, our families were gathered, and the congregation had given its witness; we were "marked with the Cross of Christ and Sealed by the Holy Spirit."

This baptism had a formal influence in my life, as I am now a Pastor, however, it was nowhere near even being remotely evident in my mind, my mind's eye, or my family that this would one day be the case in my (and our life) ...

I never imagined myself becoming a Pastor; or for that matter having any role in a church setting at all, and especially not standing in front of people...talking...

As a side note, as I look back over my life, and a number of "events" or "circumstances" that had occurred; this path was no doubt laid out before me...hindsight, as they say...but it was something that was nowhere on my radar as something that would be a part of my life's work and service.

To make a long story short, we don't know what tomorrow will bring; just as we don't know the impact today's events will have on our tomorrow's...

We do, however, know exactly that impact our baptism has on our lives...yesterday, today, and tomorrow...that impact is life itself.

Now just exactly how our being washed in the waters of Baptism effects eternal life for us, is truthfully beyond our comprehension...

Theologically however, as scripture, and the Apostle Paul says."

'we are drowned in the waters of baptism, and we are raised a new creation in Christ...'

'Our old "Adam(s)", and our old "Eve(s)" are drowned in those waters, and a new creation is made...'

'When we were baptized in Christ Jesus, we were baptized into his death. We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, so that as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the father, we too might live a new life. For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we shall certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his.'

Jesus' baptism, our baptisms; these are not mere symbolic efforts made to look good to ourselves, or to endear us to God...it is an act of grace done to us...commanded to us by Christ Jesus

"¹⁹Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit," [Matthew 28:19 NRSV]

On January 1, 2024 I begin my first call at Zion's Lutheran Church in Shoemakersville, PA.

It seems impossible that it has been almost 18 months since we began our journey together. It is extremely difficult to be saying good-bye.

I want to thank you all for your support and prayers as we learned and grew together. We have accomplished so much in our time together as God blessed us with inspiration, lead us down new pathways and reignited our enthusiasm for serving our neighbors.

We resumed ministry practices that were put on hold during the pandemic – Altar Guild, pastoral visits, and Lay Eucharistic Ministry visits. We found new ways to revitalize ministries from the past – Sunday school singers (children's choir), Camp Noah blankets (crafters Group), Prayer shawl ministry (crafters group) and Blessing bags for the homeless (food pantry). Things to come in 2024:

Beginning January, we will be initiating some new ongoing NO COST collections that will continue throughout the year.

1. Collection basket to receive used eyeglasses and sunglasses, prescription and non-prescription, for adults and children. These will be donated to Lions Club Recycle for Sight effort.
2. Collection basket to receive aluminum pull tabs from containers like soda cans, pet food cans, etc. The Ronald McDonald House in Danville works with a local recycler to turn those tabs into money to support their family services.
3. Collection basket to receive cancelled postage stamps from your mail. The Frackville Elks collects these and donates them to military organizations and are used to help veterans in hobby therapy efforts.

5. The prayer shawl ministry is also continuing into the future.
