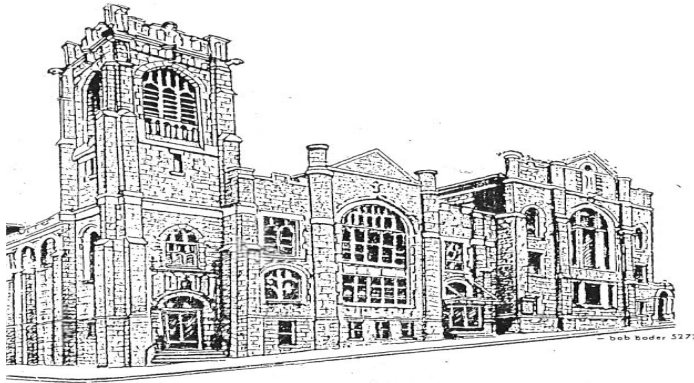

Brothers and sisters in Christ Jesus,

As we head into the months of March and April; into the seasons of Lent and Easter, I want to take a quick jaunt back to January...not this January (although the bitter cold temps and ice we have dealt with this winter also brings specific events back to my mind...) I am speaking specifically of early January 1996...from which most of you may recall a massive snowstorm.

There was a LOT going on in my life during that time. My youngest daughter was on her way (she would be born February 1, 1996). We had moved to a new home in West Reading in April of 1994, and I had begun walking to work that winter to save money from parking, however, as her birth was pending at any time, I had begun to drive to work again in case I had to return home quickly.

Thankfully everything worked out very well and timely, and we were blessed with another beautiful daughter.

However, there was one specific encounter I had experienced right before we were inundated with more than 3 feet of snow.

I had parked about 6 blocks away from the building in which I worked, and as I was making my way from my car to the office building this specific morning, I encountered an older woman at a crosswalk on the corner of South Eighth and Penn Streets in the City of Reading.

The sidewalks were glazed with a fresh coating of ice; not an abundance, but enough to make walking difficult. Why she was out in such conditions, to this day I do not know, but as I arrived at the corner she asked if I could help her walk back to her apartment.

I responded that I was late getting to work and that I was unable to help her...yes, even as I type this a sense of guilt and shame washes over me still.

She again pleaded with me for my assistance, and after asking a second time I agreed to walk her back. It turned out she lived only a block or two in the opposite direction from which I was headed.

As we arrived at her apartment building doorway, she thanked me, and I said I was glad to have helped her. (I honestly was because even though it made me a few minutes late for work, the small effort it took for me to walk with her, was well worth the feeling of having helped someone in a difficult situation).

Even though I arrived at work about 5 or 10 minutes later, everything was okay from that standpoint.

As we have moved into the season of Lent, marching quickly toward Easter, this story has prophetic, Biblical meaning for me...and hopefully for us all.

As we journey toward Easter, making our own ways through our Lenten wilderness encounters, we will arrive at the Cross.

At this point we are reminded of the events with Jesus and the disciples in the Garden of Gethsemane:

*<sup>37</sup>He took with him Peter and the two sons of Zebedee, and began to be grieved and agitated. <sup>38</sup>Then he said to them, "I am deeply grieved, even to death; remain here, and stay awake with me." <sup>39</sup>And going a little farther, he threw himself on the ground and prayed, "My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from me; yet not what I want but what you want." <sup>40</sup>Then he came to the disciples and found them sleeping; and he said to Peter, "So, could you not stay awake with me one hour? <sup>41</sup>Stay awake and pray that you may not come into the time of trial; the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak." <sup>42</sup>Again he went away for the second time and prayed, "My Father, if this cannot pass unless I drink it, your will be done."*

*[Matthew 26.37-42 NRSV]*

It is at our intersection in life that we encounter our crosses. As did I that icy January morning, initially echoing the words of Jesus as the older woman asked for my assistance, mentally I responded with words similar to:

*'My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from me...'*

I didn't want to take the time to help her... ***Guilty as charged!***

But as she asked the second time, mentally I responded with words similar to:

*'...yet not what I want but what you want. And...'*

*'... "My Father, if this cannot pass unless I drink it, your will be done.'*

She asked me a second time, and I was given a second chance to help someone in need.

In similar words, Jesus himself did not want to drink the cup; He did not want to go through the pains of Good Friday. Ultimately...

**HE DID SO FOR YOU AND ME...FOR US!**

In the book of Genesis, it says God created the heavens and earth and all things that dwell therein in six days...and on the seventh day, God rested...

Lent, Holy Week, and Easter remind us that while God leisurely rested after creating all things, His act of recreating everything through His Son...our Lord and savior Christ Jesus...

Required so much for our benefit that it caused God (the creator of all things) to endure tremendous suffering...

<sup>39</sup>He came out and went, as was his custom, to the Mount of Olives; and the disciples followed him. <sup>40</sup>When he reached the place, he said to them, "Pray that you may not come into the time of trial." <sup>41</sup>Then he withdrew from them about a stone's throw, knelt down, and prayed,  
<sup>42</sup>"Father, if you are willing, remove this cup from me; yet, not my will but yours be done." <sup>43</sup>Then an angel from heaven appeared to him and gave him strength. <sup>44</sup>**In his anguish he prayed more earnestly, and his sweat became like great drops of blood falling down on the ground.**  
*[Luke 22:39-44 NRSV]*

We cannot ever properly nor adequately thank God in Christ Jesus enough for the work done for us as we stand on the corners in our lives simply asking for help. Help which God in Christ Jesus gave, and continues to give, everything for each of us.

Thanks be to God!

May you all have a blessed and safe Lenten journey and may the peace of Easter and our Risen Lord and Savior Christ Jesus be with you all now and always!!
