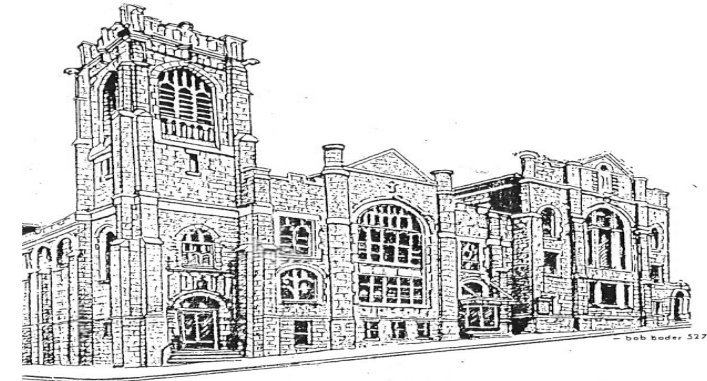

Sisters and brothers in Christ Jesus,

Alleluia, Christ is Risen!

He is risen indeed, alleluia!

We echo this response each year at Easter. But oftentimes, a question arises...Christmas or Easter...which carries more weight.

We have pondered this question at times during worship...and it has long been debated within the historical church.

The simple answer is neither...and both. For the true answer isn't which date or which event, but rather **whom** is the focus of both, and what significance occurs at each.

The answer is Christ Jesus. Born, and raised to new life.

In both instances God has broken into human history, our world, our individual lives, and as a result of Christ Jesus actions, has created us anew.

Jesus Conversation with Nicodemus from the Gospel of John paints this picture for us...

John 3:1-10:

1 Now there was a Pharisee named Nicodemus, a leader of the Jews.

2 He came to Jesus by night and said to him, "Rabbi, we know that you are a teacher who has come from God; for no one can do these signs that you do apart from the presence of God." **3** Jesus answered him, "Very truly, I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God without being born from above."

4 Nicodemus said to him, "How can anyone be born after having grown old? Can one enter a second time into the mother's womb and be born?" **5** Jesus answered, "Very truly, I tell you, no one God has reached out delivering us from temptation...and forgiving our sins, as we forgive others..."

can enter the kingdom of God without being born of water and Spirit. **6**

What

is born of the flesh is flesh, and what is born of the Spirit is spirit. **7** Do not be astonished that I said to you, "You must be born from above."

8 The wind blows where it chooses, and you hear the sound of it, but you do not know where it comes from or where it goes. So it is with everyone who is born of the Spirit." **9** Nicodemus said to him, "How can these things be?" **10** Jesus answered him, "Are you a teacher of Israel, and yet you do not understand these things?"

And the women who were first to arrive at Jesus' tomb finishes the picture...

Mark 16:1-7:

1 When the sabbath was over, Mary Magdalene, and Mary the mother of James, and Salome bought spices, so that they might go and anoint him. **2** And very early on the first day of the week, when the sun had risen, they went to the tomb. **3** They had been saying to one another, "Who will roll away the stone for us from the entrance to the tomb?" **4** When they looked up, they saw that the stone, which was very large, had already been rolled back. **5** As they entered the tomb, they saw a young man, dressed in a white robe, sitting on the right side; and they were alarmed. **6** But he said to them, "Do not be alarmed; you are looking for Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified. He has been raised; he is not here. Look, there is the place they laid him. **7** But go, tell his disciples and Peter that he is going ahead of you to Galilee; there you will see him, just as he told you."

Easter or Christmas?

Christ Jesus!

Like a parent instinctively reaching out to protect their young child who is about to fall into danger, so too has God reached out, not once, not even twice, but through Jesus' birth and resurrection, has set in motion God's eternal reaching out to us, for us, with our salvation, with our daily bread...
