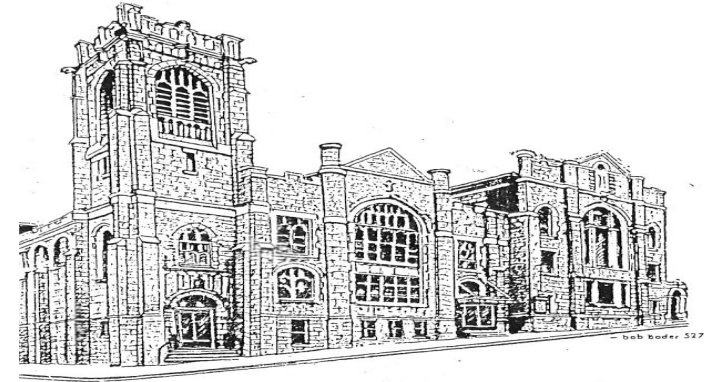

There are some in the larger church that would chastise me for starting a church letter with a symbol recognizing our 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary as a nation...

Nevertheless...our history is part of our faith, and our faith is part of our history.

Regardless of how people may effort to separate the two, one thing is for sure, not just with the USA, but with all the world's history... We cannot tell the history of humanity without religion...and we cannot tell the story of religion without history...the two go hand-in-hand

And to this end, it is a part of our history, and mine as well.

Prior to July 4, 1776, a few things, from a religious and historical standpoint occurred.

September 6, 1711, Henry Melchior Muhlenber was born in Einbeck, Germany. He was educated as a Lutheran pastor, and in 1742, he was commissioned and sent by the religious leaders in Halle, Germany, to the fledgling American colonies; specifically, to arrive in Pennsylvania by the request of Lutherans in need of pastoral leadership in the greater Philadelphia area.

Upon his arrival to the American colonies in Georgia in 1742, he began his trek north toward Pennsylvania, making stops along the way and enhancing Lutheran worship practices and congregations as he traveled.

Upon arriving in Pennsylvania, and benefitting from local influence, he eventually married Anna Weiser, daughter of Conrad Weiser (Berks County) in 1745.

History-faith-religion-Lutheranism...all tied together...you cannot tell one without the other.

Eventually, Henry and Anna had six children, re-established, or much more appropriately established and organized the worship practices of the Lutheran church in the American colonies.

A few of Henry's children were also instrumental in the founding of the USA 250 years ago. Peter Muhlenberg was a Major General in the Continental Army under George Washington. Frederick became the first speaker of the House in the US Congress, Henry, Jr. became a pastor in New Jersey, and Henry Ernst became the first President of Franklin and Marshall College in Lancaster, known then as Franklin College.

Henry himself lived by the motto "Ecclesia Plantanda," the church must be planted, or in other words, we must ensure the birth, growth, and vitality of the church for our faith.

Henry went on to plant and build Lutheran congregations throughout our area, and at its height, he served almost 30 Lutheran congregations simultaneously in the eastern region of Pennsylvania. Making his way around his circuit of churches over many years.

Which also bought the practice of only receiving Holy Communion a few times a year...only when pastor Muhlenberg was present for worship.

Henry and Anna, as well as some of their children, are buried behind the old Augustus Lutheran Church in the town of Trappe, Montgomery County, PA. Their homestead is located about half a mile east of the old Trappe Church along West Main Street. Muhlenberg College in Bethlehem is also named after Henry.

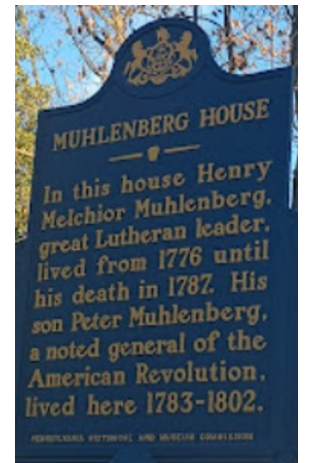
250 years of American history is intrinsically tied to our, and my faith, and my family. We cannot separate the two.
